# Give your students the opportunity to become positive leaders by encouraging them to actively participate in their school breakfast program! Here are some innovative ideas:

## Appoint a delivery team!

- Help transport deliveries from the front door to the storage area
- Help to unpack and put away the delivery

### Start a Recycling Squad!

- Separate the recycling from all the used packaging
- Rinse the recyclable items that require it (milk, yogurt)

#### Morning prep squad! \*a great volunteer opportunity for morning daycare students!

- Help to prepare the breakfast (and bins or bags for classroom breakfast programs)
- Verify the refrigerator temperature & check the adherence of MAPAQ safety standards

#### Service team!

- Participate in the service station to distribute the breakfast (students hand out the items, explain the choices from each food category, say a kind word to start the day)
- Where applicable, bring the bin or bags to class every morning
- Prepare a blackboard version of the week's menu

- Choose themes of discussion for the breakfast period
- Decorate the breakfast room or classroom for breakfast on holidays or special occasions
