VOLUNTEER ROLES

BREAKFAST PROGRAM COORDINATORS/HEAD VOLUNTEERS:

They make sure that day-to-day operations, including food preparation, meal service and cleanup activities, run smoothly. They look over other volunteers and see to it that everyone works together as a team to comply with all health, safety and hygiene regulations and to uphold the values of the school and Breakfast Club of Canada.

Training can be provided by the Club prior to taking up these duties. Breakfast program coordinators/head volunteers receive ongoing support from a BCC coordinator whose job is to work closely with each program to ensure its operational efficiency and long-term viability.

BREAKFAST CHAMPIONS/VOLUNTEERS:

Breakfast champions/volunteers help prepare and serve breakfast and clean up afterwards. They may come in once or several times a week. Exact schedules are determined in advance based on individual availability and the needs of the breakfast program they are assigned to.

The time commitment can vary from one program to the next, depending on the menu and delivery model. Volunteers prepare, cook and serve food. They then clean the equipment and premises at the end of their shift. They are expected to follow the instructions of the breakfast program coordinator/head volunteer and abide by all health, safety and hygiene requirements.

ALL VOLUNTEERS MUST:

- Submit to a criminal background check before starting their implication.
- Come in as scheduled and advise the appropriate person of any conflicts that will prevent them from coming in as planned.
- Carry out the required tasks as instructed, following all safety standards and the relevant health and hygiene regulations.
- Abide by the school's code of ethics.
- Refrain from taking or sharing any photos or videos without authorization.
- Show respect for all students, fellow volunteers and school staff, and act in a way that reflects the Club's values.
