#### Here is an overview of our support models

#### Partnership with a school

The Club directly supports the school.

#### **Community partnership**

The Club supports both a community organization offering certain services to schools and the schools served by the organization.

#### Partnership with a group of schools

The Club supports several schools at the same time, often grouped under one school authority.

#### Partnership with a high-level group

The Club supports a regional or provincial organization which serves several schools.
